TERMS & CONDITIONS & RESERVATIONS

To reserve a position on a tour, submit this application with a \$750.00 deposit, a color photocopy of passport picture page and 4 passport size photos. You will be sent confirmation and more information about the tour. Invoices are usually posted 120 days prior to tour departure with final payments due no later than 90 days prior to departure.

COVERED EXPENSES

Accommodations are based on double occupancy at hotels. Single room arrangements are usually available for a supplemental cost. We will do our best to find a suitable roommate for those desiring one, but if one is not available, you will be given a single room and charged a single supplement. We reserve the right to raise the trip cost if there are exceptional cost increases beyond our control. Land cost includes all accommodations, all breakfasts, services of guides, cooks, porters, drivers, most airport transfers and ground transportation. **Not included** are: international airfare (except for the Lhasa to Kathmandu return flights), passports, visas, (exception Tibet) immunizations, insurance of any kind, medical costs, cost of evacuation from remote areas, alcoholic beverages, laundry, excess baggage charges, expenses arising from the delay or extension of a trip due to weather, political disputes, illness, failure of transportation or other causes beyond our reasonable control, tips to guides and staff at tour end.

MEDICAL AND HEALTH

It is vital that persons with medical problems make them known to us well before departure. The trip leader has the right to disqualify anyone at any time during the trip if he/she feels the tour member is incapable of safely completing the trip, or if a tour member's continued participation might jeopardize the safety of the group. Refunds are not given under such circumstances.

INSURANCE

Due to the strenuous nature of our trips and the remoteness of our destinations, insurance is highly recommended. While Himalayan Roadrunners will attempt to secure the services of a doctor in case of an emergency, we cannot guarantee the same, and assume no liability regarding provision of medical care. We strongly urge each tour member to take out travel insurance to cover themselves for trip cancellation, Intl. flights, and medical evacuation.

TOUR BALANCE PAYMENTS, CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

Tour balance invoices are posted 120 days prior to the tour start date. Tour balance payments due 90 days prior to tour departure date. If you cancel your reservation, your deposit will be returned less a cancellation fee as follows. (Computed from the date of our receipt of your written or emailed cancellation notice.) More than 120 days - \$250 (as credit towards another tour), 91-120 days - \$500. 61-90 days - 25% of land tour cost, 31-60 days - 50% of land tour cost, 11-30 days - 80% of land tour cost., less than 10 days - 100% of land tour cost. International airline ticket refunds are the responsibility of the tour participant, so please ensure purchase of adequate tour cancellation insurance at the time of tour balance invoice payments and air ticket purchases.

Himalayan Roadrunners reserves the right to cancel any tour up to two weeks prior to tour start date for any reason whatsoever, including insufficient sign-up or logistical problems which will impede trip operations. In this case, the applicant will be notified forthwith, and payment refunded in full, which will constitute full settlement. Himalayan Roadrunners is not responsible for non-recoverable expenses incurred by trip members in preparing for a canceled trip, such as non-refundable advance purchase air tickets, visa fees, equipment, etc., nor for any necessary additional arrangements should the applicant have embarked prior to the group's departure date. In the event a tour cannot be started or must be interrupted or ended for reasons outside the control of Himalayan Roadrunners, its agents, outfitters, or contractors as in the case of but not limited to: civil unrest, riots, strike, government restrictions, earthquake, floods, or other forces of nature, this contract becomes invalid. Himalayan Roadrunners is not responsible for extra expenses incurred as result of a tour delayed beyond the published tour end date due to flight or other delays, which includes extra nights in hotels and meals.

Himalayan Roadrunners reserves the right to accept, decline, or retain any tour member from any tour at any time, and to cancel any contract on grounds of a tour member not complying with local traffic laws or Himalayan Roadrunners requirements for group travel. Tour members agree to accept the authority and rules of Himalayan Roadrunners, its guides, outfitters and contractors.

MOTORCYCLE DAMAGE DEPOSIT

A safety deposit of USD \$1500. is required prior to tour departure, and this can be secured using a credit card via our website www.ridehigh.com, this is an authorization process only and no charges will appear on your card unless damages are incurred to motorcycle while on tour. While Himalayan Roadrunners makes every effort to supply a back-up motorcycle and/or spares in the event of a mechanical breakdown, Himalayan Roadrunners is not obliged to replace a damaged motorcycle.

ASSUMPTION OF ALL RISKS AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I hereby acknowledge that during my participation in this tour arranged by Himalayan Roadrunners, their agents, outfitters and contractors, there are risks and dangers that may arise including but not limited to: motorcycle operation, dangers of traveling in mountainous terrain, high altitude, forces of nature, civil unrest, terrorism, travel by aircraft, truck, bus, jeep, car, motorcycle, rickshaw, watercraft, elephant, yak, or other means of transportation, accident or illness in remote areas without means for rapid evacuation or availability of medical supplies and facilities. I hereby release Himalayan Roadrunners, their agents, guides, outfitters, and contractors from any and all liability arising from death, illness, injury, emotional trauma, delay, loss or damage to personal property, negligence or recklessness of any kind, and from any and all claims, demands, or expenses resulting from my participation on the tour. I acknowledge that the enjoyment and excitement of adventure travel is derived in part from the inherent risks incurred by travel and activity beyond the accepted safety of life at home or work and that these inherent risks contribute to such enjoyment and excitement, being a reason for my participation.

The above Assumption of All Risks and Release of Liability provisions apply to all members of my family, including any minors accompanying me, and are binding upon myself, my heirs, legal representatives, and assigns.

I have carefully read and agree to all the conditions as stated under "Terms and Conditions", especially noting the policy of "Reservations", and "Cancellation and Refunds." I have also read the above paragraphs "Assumption of All Risks" and "Release of Liability" contract, and I agree to the same.
